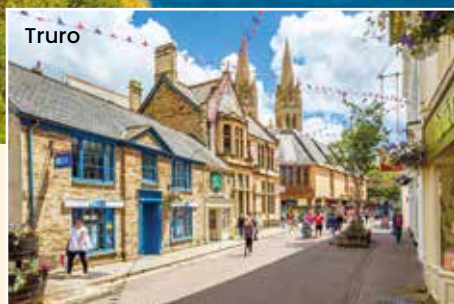

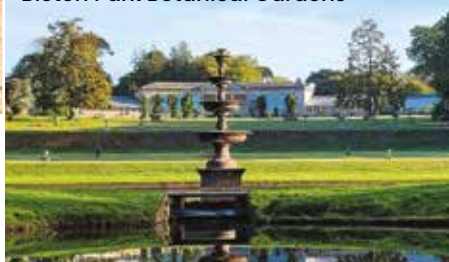
Exmouth & East Devon 5 Days

Bicton Park Botanical Gardens

With a history going back hundreds of years, Bicton Park Botanical Gardens has more than 60 acres of varied gardens, including classic formal designs and areas of natural beauty. Wander through the arboretum among some of the most majestic trees in the country, marvel at the colour in the Italian garden, or admire rare species collected from around the world.

Woodland Railway + Devon Cream Tea

At Bicton, get on board the miniature steam train for a 25-minute journey through the Pinetum to the Hermitage summerhouse at the far end of the gardens, returning alongside the lake. Also included is a voucher for a tasty cream tea in the gardens' restaurant.
